AERIAL AND GROUND NOXIOUS WEED SPRAY PROGRAMME 2003-2004

Property owners, recreational and other users of the riverbeds as listed below are advised that spraying by helicopter and ground spraying is to be carried out to control noxious weeds, namely gorse and broom. Chemicals to be used may include Trounce and Grazon for aerial spraying, and Trounce, Grazon and Tordon for ground spraying. Surfactants and anti-drift additives may also be used. The work to be carried out will commence no earlier than the 1st October and will continue intermittently as weather permits until 31st March 2004. No spraying shall occur during the period 20 December to 10 January inclusive.

The river channels involved for herbicide spraying are:

1. Wairaki River from 2 km above the transmission lines to SH 95 road bridge.
2. Aparima River from Jacobs Bridge to Dunrobin bridge.
3. Whitestone River below Glen Echo Station to the Mararoa confluence
4. Mararoa River from the Key Bridge upstream
5. Upukerora River
