TENURE REVIEW - BIRDWOOD

The following report provides an assessment of the Fish and Game values associated with the Birdwood property.

1. The Ahuriri River is a trout fishery of national importance, whilst Ribbonwood Creek is an intermittent spawning tributary of this river.
2. We request that the marginal strips are retained alongside the Ahuriri River and that marginal strips are laid off alongside Ribbonwood Creek where it is within the property.
