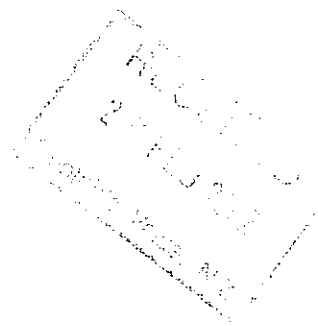
Fish & Game Report

FERINTOSH TENURE REVIEW

The following outlines the fish and game values associated with Ferintosh Station.

1. Lake Pukaki has a self sustaining trout fishery. The 1994/96 National Angling Survey estimated 623 angler days per season are spent at Lake Pukaki. Two of the more popular fishing spots around Lake Pukaki are the mouth areas of Whale Stream and Jack Stream.
2. Fish and Game request that access be made available for anglers to the stream mouths, from State Highway 80, as part of the tenure review process. This may be catered for, in the setting off of marginal strips.
