Scholarships

1. Each scholarship is up to a maximum of NZ\$5,000 for undergraduate or postgraduate course fees for Geographic Information Science (GIS) related courses taken during the period of 2019-2021 academic years.
2. Scholarship payments are on the basis of fees reimbursement after passing approved courses and the scholarship holder supplying official receipts and transcript results to LINZ.
3. Key eligible GIS related courses are those listed on the LINZ website under About LINZ > Our location strategy > Growing New Zealand's Geospatial Industry > Studying GIS > [New Zealand Tertiary GIS papers, programmes and contacts](#). Applicants can email LINZ at scholarships@linz.govt.nz to enquire about eligibility of other GIS related courses that may not be listed at the above link.
4. In each Academic year, LINZ will typically award one undergraduate and one postgraduate tertiary GIS scholarship. LINZ reserves the right to award no scholarships or to award a greater number of scholarships. LINZ's decisions about awarding or not awarding scholarships are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Process

5. Applications are open from 17 Sep 2018 until 31 Oct 2018. Late applications will not be considered.
6. Applications for GIS Scholarships must be made on this Application form. Applicants will receive a confirmation email that their application has been received.
7. Referees will be contacted for shortlisted applicants.
8. A notification email about whether an application has been successful or not will usually be sent within six weeks of the application closing date.

Eligibility

9. Applications are open to students enrolled at a New Zealand university or other New Zealand tertiary institute who are New Zealand citizens or permanent residents and also:
 - (for undergraduate scholarship) have completed their first year of tertiary studies or will complete it during 2018
 - (for post graduate scholarship) have completed an undergraduate qualification or will complete one during 2018
10. If you are currently employed, engaged or contracted by LINZ then you are not eligible for the GIS Scholarships.

Selection criteria

11. Selection of successful applicants will be based on the following:
 - Eligibility requirements being met
 - Information provided by each applicant including a letter stating why they are taking and/or plan to take GIS related courses
 - Prior tertiary study results
 - Referee feedback (for shortlisted applicants).

Privacy
