Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 5 September 2023 for information about the status of two consents (201900225 and 201900473) for Since20181 Development Limited. You noted that many of the milestone dates for the conditions have passed, and requested any information we have regard ng the approvals.

We can confirm that we are currently investigating Since20181's compliance with its consent conditions. However, as the matter is under active investigation, we cannot provide any further information about the case without prejudicing the investigation.

Accordingly, in respect of this investigation, your request for additional details is refused under section 6(c) of the Official Information Act as release would prejudice the maintenance of the law, including he investigation of offences. We are of the view the withholding of the information is not outweighed by the public interest to make that information available.
