## Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 1 March 2024 for "a copy of the OIO's Assessment Report for case 202300490 - Kōwhai Park P Limited Partnership."

Some of the information you have requested is enclosed. However, information relating to:

- the consideration for the transaction;
- the membership of the investment committee and its rules of operation;
- the capital expenditure, investment amount and expected revenue;
- the identity of grazing leaseholders;
- the development and construction costs; and
- the dates for completion of development and construction

has been refused under section 9(2)(b)(ii) of the Official Information Act 1982 (the **Act**) as release would be likely to unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.

In addition, information relating to one of the vendors and the signature of the LINZ manager has been refused under section 9(2)(a) of the Act in order to protect the privacy of natural persons.

We are of the view the withholding of the information is not outweighed by the public interest to make that information available.
