## Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 4 March 2024 for any other documentation giving more detail about case number 202300190 or the Stride Property acquisition.<sup>1</sup>

With your agreement, we have responded to your request by providing the assessment report for case number 202300190.

Some of the information you have requested is enclosed (i.e., a redacted copy of the assessment report). However, release of information relating to:

- a. capital expenditure, area of each lot to be developed, site plan, timeframe for the investment and for meeting some consent conditions has been refused under section 9(2)(b)(ii) of the Official Information Act as the release would likely unreasonably prejudice the commercial position of the consent holder; and
- b. the signatures of LINZ staff, names of certain individuals and the reason why the vendor is selling the land has been refused under section 9( )(a) of the Official Information Act to protect personal privacy.

We are of the view the withholding of the information is not outweighed by the public interest in making that information available.
