
## Proposal considered by the NZGB on 2 April 2020 for:

Māhia Canyon [altered from Poverty Canyon]



## **Summary** At its hui on 18 October 2019 the NZGB requested that the UFNC<sup>1</sup> consider a proposal to alter the recorded (unofficial) undersea feature name Poverty Canyon to Waipaoa Canyon.

At its hui on 3 February 2020 the UFNC agreed that the proposed ancestral name is not appropriate as the canyon is not hydrologically connected to Waipaoa River. The UFNC noted a smaller tributary to the main canyon and agreed that using a name associated with a nearby onshore feature clearly indicates that there is a link. The UFNC agreed that it would be more appropriate to name the feature Māhia Canyon in association with Mahia Peninsula<sup>2</sup>, which is a significant feature on nearby land.

A Te Taura Whiri i te Reo Māori licenced translator has confirmed that Māhia is the correct orthography<sup>3</sup>. Three unofficial 'Mahia' names are included in the orthographic standardisation project – see agenda item 15.2.

Approximately 5.5km of the canyon's ~72km extent is within New Zealand's 12NM territorial limit, so a proposal to alter would be publicly notified for submissions.

If Poverty Canyon is altered to Māhia Canyon it is recommended that the NZGB makes a full proposal to SCUFN<sup>4</sup>. No international consultation would be

required as the feature is not in an area of mutual interest.

## UFNC's recommendations to the NZGB

At its meeting on 2 April 2020 the NZGB resolved recommendations 1 and 2.	
Recommendation 1	<ul> <li>That the NZGB accepts the proposal to alter the recorded (unofficial) undersea feature name Poverty Canyon to an official undersea feature name Māhia Canyon based on: <ul> <li>the desire to remove 'Poverty' from the name<sup>5</sup>,</li> <li>Mahia Peninsula being a significant feature on nearby land, and</li> <li>'Māhia' being the correct orthography.</li> </ul> </li> <li>and</li> <li>That Māhia Canyon be notified as a proposal to alter for one month.</li> </ul>
and	
Recommendation 2	That if the NZGB alters Poverty Canyon to <b>Māhia Canyon</b> as an official undersea feature name that it makes a full proposal to SCUFN.
