	<ol> <li>Memorial GN 670201 – Areas shown within this memorial are stated as being hectares (ha) but should read metres squared (m2). Note – this error has not yet been corrected.</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>Memorial 829672 (note – this memorial does not show in the 'search view' but only in the 'historical search view') records a mining permit in favour of Tony Sewhoy and Brian Sewhoy. OT9D/436, the document of this memorial, shows the proprietor as John Hugh Dunn for a permit under s81 Crown Minerals Act 1991. Page two of OT9D/436 has the the plan approved by the Chief Surveyor pursuant to s29 Crown Minerals Act 1991 and in favour of the Tony Sewhoy and Brian Sewhoy. Note – this permit has subsequently been cancelled as at 12.5.2003 – refer document 5583180.1)</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>Re Appellation 657058/4.The area recited for Section 54 (ie 5.5460 ha) is incorrect. The correct area is 5.3 ha as shown on SO 21888.The area of 5.5460 ha includes Section 53 (2460m2) &amp; 54(5.3 ha). Note – this reappellation is noted on the historical image view only.</li> </ol>
	4. The legal description and area of the lease is recorded incorrectly in CT 386/52. The reason for this I suspect is because the new online Title system has not recorded the additions and deletions as recorded in the "Historical Search Copy" correctly in the "Current Search Copy".
	5. We note that Section 3 Block XIII Mid Wakatipu Survey District is shown in the lease diagram for CT 386/52. However we have searched all records and conclude that this land is not included in the lease .The status of this land is Crown Land subject to the Land Act 1948. Note – this matter has been the subject of a separate report to LINZ.
	6. Given the existence of mining permits over the land held in the pastoral lease, it is possible that mining access arrangement agreements have been granted by the lessee but not registered against the leasehold interest. There is no

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-	evidence of any such arrangements having been granted by the Crown. Although there is a note on LIPS in relation to the mining permit held by AJ Sarginson, it is not clear as to whether an access arrangement agreement has been granted
	<ul> <li>7. The following mining permits have been granted over land adjoining the Mt Creighton pastoral lease and it is possible that the permits also cover part of the lease itself;</li> <li>41-926 Daniel Gerber : mining permit for 15 years from 13.6.2006 – affects part bed of Moke Creek</li> <li>41-858 Paul Drummond : mining permit for 20 years from 3.2.2005 – affects part bed Moke Creek and Moonlight Creek</li> </ul>
