NOTICE

Under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 the Holder of Alphaburn has on the 17th day of February 2003 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a tenure review Substantive Proposal providing for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 1124 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to full Crown ownership and control as follows:
 - 1095 hectares (approximately) under section 35(2)(a)(i) of the Act as conservation area
 - 6 hectares (approximately) under section 35(2)(a)(ii) of the Act as recreation reserve; and
 - 23 hectares (approximately) under section 35(2)(a)(ii) of the Act as a government purpose reserve being a wildlife management area
- (b) 125 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to Crown control as conservation area under section 35(2)(b)(i) and section 36(1)(a) of the Act.
- (b) 3305 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of to the Holder by freehold disposal under Section 35(3) of the Act subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987;
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991
