- 1. The Quail Burn is a spawning and juvenile rearing area for the trout populations of Lake Benmore and the Ahuriri River.
- 2. We request that the marginal strips are laid off alongside the Quail Burn where it lies within the property.
- 3. We request that any wetland area as depicted on the map, and that is still in existence, is retained in full Crown ownership.
