TENURE REVIEW - BERWEN

The following report provides an assessment of the Fish and Game values associated with the Berwen property.

- 1. The Omarama and Little Omarama Streams have resident populations of brown trout. They also provide spawning habitat for the rainbow and brown trout populations of Lake Benmore and the Ahuriri River.
- 2. We request that marginal strips are laid off alongside Omarama Stream and Little Omarama Stream. This will provide for access upstream from the Broken Hut Road Bridge.
