Caithness is a property located between the Shag River and Waianakrua River catchments. The majority of the creeks are ephemeral by nature, while those containing permanent water do not contain sports fish.

Sports Fishery Values:

No sports fish were found during the survey.

Game Bird Values:

The property contains a small resident population of Paradise shelducks. Otago Fish & Game have no information on recreational hunting on this property. Access is at the discretion of the leaseholder.
