NOTICE

Under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 the Holder of Double Hill has on the 6th day of May 2003 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a tenure review Substantive Proposal providing for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 4718 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to full Crown ownership and control under section 35(2)(a)(i) of the Act as conservation area;
- (b) 179 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to Crown control under section 35(2)(b)(i) and section 36(1)(a) of the Act, subject to an easement concession in favour of the Holder as outlined in this Substantive Proposal; and
- (c) 2913 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under Section 35(3) of the Act subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987;
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991; and
 - The Easements outlined in this Substantive Proposal.
