- 1. The Omarama Stream and has a resident population of brown trout. It is also a spawning ground and juvenile rearing area for the rainbow and brown trout populations of the Ahuriri River and Lake Benmore.
- 2. We request that marginal strips are laid off alongside Omarama Stream where it lies within the property.
