Now, therefore, I, Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly, the Now, therefore, I, Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and in exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and direct that the said work described in the Schedule hereto, and known as "the Hurunui-Greta Bridge," shall, from and after the date of this Proclamation, be under the exclusive care and control and management of the Cheviot County care and control and management of the Cheviot County Council; and in further pursuance of the Cheviot County Council; and in further pursuance of the aforesaid powers and authorities I do hereby fix and determine that the cost of maintaining, repairing, improving, or reconstructing the said bridge shall be borne by the Cheviot County Council in the proportion of ninety per centum and the Waipara Road Board ten per centum of the cost. And I do hereby fix and determine that the cost of main-taining remaining improving or reconstructing the said

taining, repairing, improving, or reconstructing the said bridge from time to time shall be borne by the said local bodies in the said proportions respectively.

And I do hereby also further direct that any contribution hereby required to be made as aforesaid by the Waipara Road Board shall be paid from time to time out of the funds of the said Road Board, within a period of thirty days after demand in writing made by or on behalf of the Cheviot County Council, and all such payments shall be made from time to time to the Clerk of the said County Council, for and on account of such Road Board.

SCHEDULE.

THAT bridge, known as the Harunui-Greta Bridge, which crosses the Hurunui River at a point about two miles and a half below the confluence of the Kaiwara River with the Hurunui River, the site of the said bridge being shown upon the plan marked S.G. 25395, deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Lauds and Survey, at Wellington, in the Wellington Land District, and thereon marked A.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly; Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at the Government House, at Wellington, this twelfth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight.
