Special Provisions

The Lessee shall take a half share as tenant-in-common over a licence to occupy issued under section 68 of the Land Act 1948, over Section 1, Block XIII and Section 1 Block XIV Wart Hill Survey District.

The Lessee shall at all times, together with the Licensee of Run 609, Wart Hill Survey District, maintain the sheep-bridge over the Pomahaka River at Section 1, Block XIII Wart Hill Survey District, in good order and condition to the satisfaction of the Commissioner.

Area adjustments

There have been no area changes since the lease was renewed in 1989.

Registered interests

Electricity Agreement

The property is subject to X12258 Electricity Agreement under the Electricity Agreement Act 1948. The agreement outlines the conditions upon which the Southland Electric Power Board will supply electricity to the lease.

Water Right

Transfer 206413 describes the grant of rights to take and convey water from a spring over part of the land described in Certificate of Title 228/212

Unregistered interests

There are no known unregistered interests against the lease.

4. Summarise any Government programmes approved for the lease:

A search of the file indicates that there are no Government programmes approved or operating in the lease.

5. Summary of Land Status Report:

A Land Status Report was undertaken by Opus International Consultants Limited on 24 November 2000. This confirms the status of the land as Crown Land under the Land Act 1948, pursuant to section 66 of the Land Act 1948, and registered under section 83 of the Land Act 1948.

The following items were identified for possible consideration in the Context of Due Diligence:

- 1. Appurtenant right created by Transfer 206413 is appurtenant to Section 2, Block XVIII, Wart Hill Survey District. Surrender Document 326048 has surrendered this area from the lease.
- 2. A condition of this lease is that the Lessee shall at all times maintain the sheep-bridge at present exisiting over the Pomahaka River at Section 1, Block XIII, Wart Hill Survey District in good order and condition to the satisfaction of the Commissioner.
- 3. A field inspection may be required to ascertain if Gem Lake, Gem Creek, Jordan or Black Creek, Island Creek and other streams within this pastoral lease could be subject to Section 24 of the Conservation Act 1987. No evidence has been found that this aspect was considered on renewal of this lease on 1 January 1989. The Riverbank Reserve created under section 129 of the Land Act 1924 along the Pomahaka River is now deemed to be a marginal strip of the same width (section 24 (3) Conservation Act 1987 effective date 10/4/1990) the boundaries of the marginal strip do no change (section 24G (7) Conservation Act 1987).
- 4. The Pomahaka River is subject to a Statutory Acknowledgement in terms of the Ngai Tahu Claims Settlement Act 1998.

6. Review of topographical and cadastral data:

A review of the topographical and cadastral plans attached to the Land Status Report reveals that there are no communication sites, airstrips, or treatment sites on the property.

On Run 755, a series of High Tension power lines runs through the length of the property.
