Under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 the Holder of Glenariffe has on the 7th day of February 2005 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a tenure review Substantive Proposal providing for the following designations in respect of the land:

The Substantive Proposal provides for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 3,173 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to full Crown ownership and control as conservation area under Section 35(2)(a)(i) of the Act;
- (b) 33 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to crown control as conservation area, subject to a qualified designation under Section 35(2)(b)(i) and Section 36(1) of the Act;
 - Farm Access and Access for Repairs and Maintenance of a Water Intake Concession
- (c) 1,593 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under Section 35(3) of the Act, subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987'
 - Section 11 Crown Minerals Act 1991;
 - Public Access and for Minister of Conservation Management Purposes Easement in Gross
 - The continuation in force of a Land Improvement Agreement, registered number 324721.1 pursuant to Section 30A Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941.
