Hi Geoff

After last weeks discussion with you I am advising that Fish and Game no longer wishes to undertake an inspection of the Glenlee property. This decision has been based on several reasons, one being the indication that the majority of the property is to be retained in crown ownership, managed by DoC. Secondly DoC in compiling their resources report have already undertaken extensive electric fishing on the property and an inspection by Fish and Game is unlikely to add any value to that assessment. Finally, we are now very busy and would not be able to commit any staff resources before the end of this year, and do not wish to delay the review process. Thank you for the opportunity to comment.
