
### **Due Diligence Report (including Status Report) - Part 11**





- (2) That the licensee shall prevent the destruction or burning of timber or bush on the land comprised in this license, except as provided by section 32 of the Land Act, 1924.
- (3) That the licensee shall prevent the growth or spread of gorse, broom, hawthorn, blackberry, and sweetbrier on the land comprised in this license, and shall speed remove or cause to be removed all gorse, sweetbrier, broom, hawthorn, blackberry, or other noxious weeds or plants, as may be directed by the Commissioner of Crown Lands;
- (4) That the licensee shall not burn any tussock on the land comprised in this license, or permit any tussock thereon to be burned save with the consent of the Land Board of the Canterbury Land District; and then only during the months of August and September.
- (5) That the licensee shall destroy all rabbits on the land comprised in this license, and shall prevent their increase or spread, to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Crown Lands appointed by him to inspect the ground;
- (6) (a) That the licensee shall exercise due care in the stocking of the land comprised in this license and in particular shall not overstock; (b) That for the purpose of this clause it is hereby mutually agreed between the Commissioner of Crown Lands and the licensee that a reasonable capacity of the lands comprised in this license is 13,000 sheep on the basis of a count of one for dry sheep, and a count of one and a half for the remainder; (c) That the licensee shall not during the winter months depasture more than the aforesaid number of sheep on the lands comprised in this license, and that the aforesaid number of sheep on the lands comprised in this license shall have been obtained;
- (d) That the licensee shall at all times exercise good husbandry in the conduct of grazing the land comprised in this license to ensure that the capacity shall be maintained and that the soil fertility and plant cover shall not be injuriously affected.
- (e) That if it is found on inspection at any time that the winter country is deteriorating it is for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to require the stock numbers to be reduced and in that case reduction in the rental shall be made. Provided also that should it become practicable to again stock the summer country it is for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to require the stock numbers to be increased and on any such increase being authorised by the Commissioner of Crown Lands a pro rata increase in the rental shall be made.
- (f) That officers and employees of the Department of Internal Affairs shall at all times have free egress and regress over the land comprised in this license for the purpose of determining whether or any adjoining land is infested with deer, wild goats, wild pigs, opossums or other animals. The Department is charged with the duty of exterminating or controlling, or for the purpose of such animals. Provided that such officers and employees in the performance of the said duty shall avoid undue disturbance of the licensee's stock.

And it is hereby declared that these presents are intended to take effect as a pasturage license only under the Land Act, 1924, and the provisions of this license shall apply hereto as fully and effectually as if the same had been set out herein at length.


