NOTICE

The Grantee gives notice under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 ("the **Act**") that the Holder has on the 24 July 2014 accepted, in accordance with Section 60 of the Act, a Substantive Proposal relating to the land in the above Computer Interest Register ("the Land").

The Substantive Proposal provides for the following designations in respect of the Land:

- (a) 12 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to or retained in Crown control under section 35(2)(b)(iv) of the Act.
- (b) 5340 hectares (approximately), to be designated as land to be restored to or retained in Crown control as Conservation Area under section 35(2)(b)(i) of the Act, subject to qualified designations being easement concessions under section 36(1)(a).
- (c) 1660 hectares (approximately), to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under section 35(3) of the Act, subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987; and
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991; and
 - Management Purposes Easement in gross under section 12 of the Reserved Act 1977.
