

CROWN PASTORAL LAND ACT 1998

KIRKLISTON TENURE REVIEW

NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY PROPOSAL

Notice is given under Section 43 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 by the Commissioner of Crown Lands that he has put a Preliminary Proposal for tenure review to Haldon Station Limited as lessee of the Kirkliston Pastoral Lease.

Legal Description of land concerned:

Part Run 329 and Rural Section 41303 Mackenzie, Hewlings and Dalzell Survey Districts

General description of proposal:

1. Approximately 1,556 hectares to be restored to full Crown ownership and control as a conservation area under section 35 (2)(a)(i) of the CPL Act.
2. Approximately 5,965 hectares to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under section 35 (3) of the CPL Act subject to the following protective mechanism:
 - i. An easement for public access and management as set out below.

Pursuant to section s40(1)(b) and s40(2)(c) of the CPL Act, the easement shall provide access for the Crown and the public with or without non-motorised vehicles powered by a person or persons or on, or accompanied by, horses.

Pursuant to s40(1)(b) and s40(2)(b) of the CPL Act, the easement shall also provide access for the Crown with motor vehicles and with or without machinery and implements of any kind but only for the purposes of conservation management of the proposed conservation land.
