Part of the information relates to research on the status of the land, resulting in a Status Report that is signed off by a LINZ approving officer. The remainder of the information is not analysed for relevancy or possible action until required, and LINZ does not guarantee its accuracy or completeness as presented.

And whereas it is expedient to make provision under the said Act for the purposes and in the manner hereinafter set forth:

forth: Now, therefore, I, Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and in exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the said Act, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and direct that the said work described in the Schedule hereto, and known as "the Hurunui-Greta Bridge," shall, from and after the date of this Proclamation, be under the exclusive care and control and management of the Cheviot County Council; and in further pursuance of the aforesaid powers and authorities I do hereby fix and determine that the cost of maintaining, repairing, improving, or reconstructing the of maintaining, repairing, improving, or reconstructing the said bridge shall be borne by the Cheviot County Council in the proportion of ninety per centum and the Waipara Road Board ten per centum of the cost.

And I do hereby fix and determine that the cost of maintaining, repairing, improving, or reconstructing the said bridge from time to time shall be borne by the said local bodies in the said proportions respectively.
