This is to confirm my telephone advice. Staff advise that there are no significant sports fish and/or game bird values on the property that need to be accommodated through the tenure review process. The known distribution of sports fish in Coal Creek extends some distance upstream of the main road, but not as far as the property boundary.

Similarly there are no angler or hunter access requirements that need to be accommodated in the review on this property.
