NOTICE

The Grantee gives notice under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 (the **Act**) that the Holder has on the 19th day of October 2005 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a Substantive Proposal relating to the land in the above Certificate of Title (“the land”):

The Substantive Proposal provides for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 130 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to or retained in Crown control under Section 35(2)(b)(i) of the Act as conservation area, subject to the granting of a grazing concession.
- (b) 400 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under Section 35(3) of the Act, subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991
 - A covenant under the Reserves Act 1977
 - The continuation in force of an easement in gross in favour of the Last Chance Irrigation Company Limited.
