NOTICE

The Grantee gives notice under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 (the **Act**) that the Holder has on the 24th day of February 2005 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a Substantive Proposal relating to the land in the above Certificate of Title (“the land”):

The Substantive Proposal provides for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 9.6950 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to or retained in full Crown ownership and control for the purpose of Riverbed (as shown marked in pink on the Plan (CA1 on Diagram 1));
- (b) 17.000 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored in Crown control as conservation area (as shown marked pink in the Plan (CA2 on diagram 1));
- (c) 161.000 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder (as shown marked green on the Plan), subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987;
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991.
