FISH AND GAME RESOURCES REPORTS

The Curraghmore and Streamlands pastoral leases are located on the eastern side of the Mackenzie Basin on Haldon Road and cover a land area of approximately 6000ha and 5840ha respectively.

The upper catchments of Stony River tributaries are included on these properties and part of Stony river itself forms the boundary of Streamlands. There are sportfish (brown trout) present on both properties. It is thought that there is little angler use of the waters on these properties however angling opportunity does exist, especially in the lower altitude parts of the properties.

Both properties are considered good upland gamebird country (chukor and quail) and suitable access for hunters should be maintained and legalised (where not already).
