The Grantee gives notice under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 (the **Act**) that the Holder has on the16th day of September 2005 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a Substantive Proposal relating to the land in the above Certificate of Title ("the land"):

The Substantive Proposal provides for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 662.2051 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to full Crown ownership and control under Section 35(2)(a)(i) of the Act as conservation area;
- (b) 21 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to full Crown ownership and control under Section 35(2)(a)(ii) of the Act as scenic reserve;
- (c) 503 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to be restored to Crown control under Section 35(2)(b)(i) and Section 36(1) of the Act as conservation area, subject to:
 - The granting of a Right of Way easement concession in favour of the holder:
 - Right to Convey Water (in Gross) created by Transfer 552944.1
- (d) 1,647 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under Section 35(3) of the Act, subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991
 - Right to Convey Water (in Gross) created by Transfer 552944.1; and
 - Public Access and Conservation Area and Vehicles for Management Purposes Easements.
