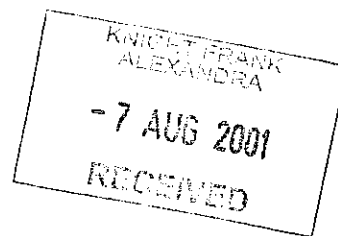

### **Knobbies and Cairnhill Tenure Review**

Re: your letter dated 31 July 2001.

Fish & Game feel that Speargrass Creek is of importance to the Speargrass Reservoir fishery. Speargrass Creek is the major spawning tributary for the reservoir; despite some reaches being channelled in the past. Adequate protection is required to prevent further channelisation and preserve the spawning and rearing habitat. Therefore, we strongly feel this water is deserving of marginal strip protection where appropriate and of conservation covenant protection where a marginal strip is not appropriate.
