NOTICE

Under Section 61 of the Crown Pastoral Land Act 1998 the Holder of West Wanaka has on the 31st day of March 2004 accepted (in accordance with Section 60 of the Act) a tenure review Substantive Proposal providing for the following designations in respect of the land:

- (a) 630 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to or retained in full Crown ownership and control under Section 35(2)(a)(i) of the Act as conservation area (marked in pink, either outlined or crosshatched on the plan);
- (b) 53 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be restored to or retained in Crown control as conservation area (marked in brown on the plan), subject to a qualified designation (a right of way concession for farm management purposes) under Section 35(2)(b)(i) and Section 36(1) of the Act;
- (c) 1480 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be disposed of by freehold disposal to the Holder under Section 35(3) of the Act (edged green on the plan), subject to:
 - Part IVA of the Conservation Act 1987;
 - Section 11 of the Crown Minerals Act 1991.
- (d) 93 hectares (approximately) to be designated as land to be retained by the holder in fee simple (marked in green crosshatching on the plan).
