<u>TENURE REVIEW – TWIN BURN</u>

The following report provides an assessment of the Fish and Game values associated with the Twin Burn property.

- 1. Omarama Stream, Boundary Creek and the Manuherikia River West Branch all have sportfishery value with resident brown trout populations and spawning habitat that contribute to the angling values in the lower reaches of these fisheries.
- 2. We request that the following be negotiated under the tenure review process
 - a) Marginal strips are set off or retained where the Omarama Stream, Boundary Creek and Manuherikia River West Branch are within the property boundaries.
 - b) Retention of legal roads.
