
#### **Motivation for Review**










- 2. Share **Title owners** as a restricted ArcGIS REST service
- 3. Create **NZ Parcel Property Boundaries**, to combine rating unit property boundaries with parcels
- 4. Update **building outlines** and improve attribution
- 5. Maintain authoritative **suburb** boundaries based on NZ Localities


## **Geological relief map of New Zealand**


#### What is "Notice of Change"

• Notice of Change (NoC) has transformed how solicitors/conveyancers notify New Zealand councils of changes of property ownership.

• The resulting process is faster, easier, cheaper and more accurate.

The solution can be adopted by almost all councils around the country.




## **Search Now and Roadmap**
