- Evidence of consultation with local iwi, marae, or other Māori groups with ancestral interests.
- For a descriptive name, evidence to support how the name describes the place or feature.
- For a personal name, evidence the person being commemorated is no longer alive, their connection with the area or feature, and the significance of their association with that place. Consultation with family is preferred.
- Audio file, for example, pronunciation of the name.
- Other supporting information.
