This note is not part of the recognition document, but is provided for information only

This document has been prepared so that it may be registered on the Marine and Coastal Area Register. It specifies the details of the recognition of customary marine title under the <u>Ngā Rohe</u> <u>Moana o Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Porou (Recognition of Customary Marine Title) Order 2020</u> (the Order) and includes contact details for the management arrangement representing the customary marine title hapū.
