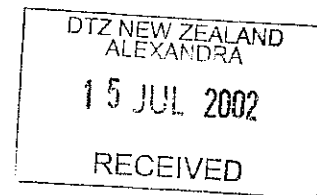

The following report provides an assessment of the Fish and Game values associated with the Dunstan Downs property.

1. Longslip Creek is an important rainbow and brown trout spawning tributary of the Ahuriri River.
2. We request that marginal strips are laid off alongside Longslip Creek to provide for angler and management access.
3. We also request that the marginal strips are retained on Dunstan Creek.
