

# MÃORI INTEREST IN SURPLUS CROWN-OWNED LAND

Notice is hereby given that the properties owned by the Crown and its agencies described in the Schedule below have been declared surplus by the Crown.

Submissions must be accompanied by the correct forms which can be obtained from the Settlement Advisor-Protection Mechanism at The Office for Māori Crown Relations - Te Arawhiti or at www.ots.govt.nz. Forms for the Protection of Sites of Significance can also be obtained from the local office of Te Puni Kōkiri. Applications for both processes must be lodged with the Settlement Advisor- Protection Mechanism at The Office for Māori Crown Relations - Te Arawhiti by 4.00 pm on Friday, 9 July 2021
