

NZ 42(P)/19 NEW ZEALAND - South Island - East Coast - Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō. Aids to Navigation Works

1. Changes to aids to navigation are underway within Lyttelton Harbour/Whakaraupō.
2. The works are being undertaken by a crane mounted on the barge *Geronimo* with attendant tug *Rosco* (call sign ZMF7771).
3. The barge is restricted in its ability to manoeuvre. Mariners are advised to maintain a minimum closest approach and no wake zone of 200m from the barge.
4. Major changes to current charted aids to navigation include:
 - a. Establishment of Purau Bay Outer leading lights.
 - b. Amendments to Main Channel leading lights.
 - c. Amendment to Navy Point and Z-Berth lights.
 - d. Numerous AIS aids to navigation are now operational.
5. Further information and charting action is to come in due course.
6. All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 12 and 16 and are advised to exercise caution when navigating in the area.
