## Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 13 February 2023 for "all communications with Messrs Khali & Khan, Turner Hopkins & any other parties LINZ has communicated with regarding caveat dealings over the last 2 years affecting the above CT [324880]".

During the two year period 13 February 2021 – 13 February 2023, we have located information relating to two calls to our contact centre and one email exchange between Samuel Ames and Siobhan Simpson.

Some of the information you have requested is enclosed. However, some information held relating to Mr Ames has been refused under section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act to protect the privacy of natural persons. Information shown in the call log and summary is the refore partially reducted.

We are of the vi w that the withholding of the information is not outweighed by other consideration which render it desirable in the public interest to make that information available.
