## Response to your official information request – Tranche 2 release

I refer to our previous letter of 9 July 2023 regarding your request for information on investigations where the OIO had taken enforcement action since May 2021.

We **enclose** with this letter the second (and final) tranche of information, namely our main internal report for each of the following cases:

It was necessary to withhold some information on the following grounds under the Official Information Act 1982:

- S9(2)(a) personal privacy
- S9(2)(b)(ii) commercial sensitivity
- S9(2)(ba)(i) information subject to an obligation of confidence
- s9(2)(g)(i) maintain the effective conduct of public affairs.

Having had the benefit of consulting with the parties on the release of this information, redactions have been kept to a minimum and the reports should provide you with a good overview of the action taken and our rationale.
