**Response to your official information request**

Thank you for your official information request received on 26 April 2023 for information on four of our Jobs for Nature projects, Lake Dunstan Restoration and Community Engagement Project, Boffa Miskell – Aquatic and Terrestrial Weeds and Pests Control – Canterbury, South Canterbury Braided Rivers Project, and South Canterbury High Country Project.

Jobs for Nature funding enabled us to expand our existing biosecurity and biodiversity programme and invest in projects that would environmentally benefit LINZ-managed Crown land.

Due to our projects predominately revolving around pest and weed control, we report quarterly to the Jobs for Nature Secretariat on three environmental metrics related to pest and weed control. We are currently on track to meet or exceed these metrics over the four years of the programme.

In response to your request, we have provided the information on each of the four projects listed in Tables 1-4 below. This includes information up to 31 March 2023, the most recent quarterly reporting period.
