Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 8 June 2023 for information pertaining to Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand (LINZ)'s insurance premiums and policies.

Some of the information you have requested is enclosed. However, information prior to 2013, as well as the request to breakdown the information by subunit, has been refused under Section 18(f) of the Official Information Act because the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.

1. How much has LINZ spent each financial year on insurance premiums from 2000 until the present?

2. How much has LINZ successfully claimed on insurance policies each year from 2000 until the present?

Information from 2013 can be found in Table 2 in Attachment 1.

3. Could you please also provide this information with respect to relevant subunits, I.e crown property management and the geospatial office.

This has been refused under Section 18(f) of the Official Information Act because the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.
