Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 20 June 2023 regarding an email sent to you notifying you of the release of a new interface for the LINZ Data Service. Specifically you requested:

"A copy of all information relating to these tracked links, including the program and person who created them, the information on where the data is stored and by whom, and a copy of the information tracked", and

"a copy of the reports, meeting agenda, meeting minutes, emails, correspondence, data, aide memoire relating to the creation of these links and the purpose of these links."

The information we have provided in relation to your request is attached as Appendix 1 and 2.
