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## Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 19 September 2023 for:

- A copy of the letter or email from Linz to Colliers instructing Colliers to issue a 'termination of lease' on the property 8-12 Amohia St, Paraparaumu and/or 3 Kapiti Road, Paraparaumu.
- 2. The total number of buildings deemed an earthquake risk under the care and management from L NZ
- 3. The total number of buildings deemed an earthquake risk that have had their leases terminated that are under LINZ care and management.

Please find enclosed the information requested, regarding question 1, in the form of an email chain between LINZ and Colliers.

Regarding question 2, we have found 25 properties which have been flagged as an earthquake hazard. Out of the 25 properties, 12 ar classified as earthquake prone, meaning they have been assessed as below 33% of the n w building standard and are considered as high risk. This number may not represent the total number of earthquake risk buildings managed by LINZ. These are the ones that we know about via notification from the council or assessment by engineer.

Regarding question 3, the information you requested being, the total number of buildings deemed an earthquake risk that have had their leases terminated that are under LINZ care and management, is not held by Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand and we have no reason to believe that it is held by another agency. Therefore, we are refusing your request under 18(g) of the Official Information Act.
