Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request for a copy of the OI Assessment Report in relation to the consent granted under the Overseas Investment Act 2005 for Sealord Group Limited to acquire Independent Fisheries Limited.

Attached is a copy of the OI Assessment Report which is released in part.

Some information has been withheld under sections:

- 6(c) as the making available of that information would be likely to prejudice the maintenance of the law, including the prevention, investigation, and detection of offences, and the right to a fair trial.
- 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons.
- 9(2)(b)(ii) as the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.
- 9(2)ba)(i) to protect information which is subject to an obligation of confidence
 where the making available of the information would be likely to prejudice the
 supply of similar information, or information from the same source, and it is in the
 public interest that such information should continue to be supplied.

We are of the view the withholding of the information is not outweighed by the public interest to make that information available.
