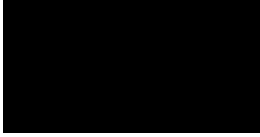
Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand (LINZ) has been undergoing an organisational change programme (Organising Ourselves) since 2020, the last phase of this programme will be implemented by end of June 2024. We have excluded the impact of this change programme in our response as the intent of the programme was not to reduce the number of established roles.

LINZ does not currently have any confirmed roles to be disestablished in 2024, so we are unable to provide information for the 1 March – 31 December 2024 period.
