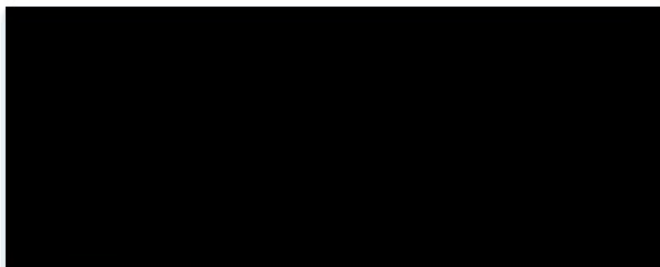


# Wall Walk
