Advanced Survey and Titles Services (ASaTS)

General Information

Land Information New Zealand (LINZ) is in the process of completing a Detailed Business Case for the modernisation of the current Landonline survey and titles system.

LINZ wishes to advise interested parties of its intention to issue a Request for Information (RFI) on 10 March 2014. This RFI is being issued in order for LINZ to get a better understanding of the number and type of suppliers and the range of solutions, technology and products or services available in order to successfully complete the Detailed Business Case required as part of the Treasury's Better Business Case model for large capital proposals.

The purpose of this notice is simply to assist the market's business planning by alerting the market to a planned procurement that is being prepared by LINZ and to give the market an outline of the requirements of the procurement and the likely date it will be advertised.
